Crisis Plan Components

- 1. Prevention - preventive action taken by schools BEFORE a threat or actual incident occurs.... *Drills*
- 2. Protection - protective actions for humans, infrastructure and sites from a threat or hazard.... *Security*
- 3. Mitigation - attempt to minimize the impact or likelihood of an event... *Mental Health Assessments*



Crisis Plan Components

- 4. Response- safety and security actions necessary to stabilize the environment DURING an emergency... *ALICE Training*

Remember to involve your County Emergency Government Official



Crisis Plan Components

- 5. Recovery - actions to restore the learning environment AFTER the event...*Reunification*

Fire, EMS, Police, Evacuation Sites,
Contract Services

Include: IC, phone tree, site contact,
accessibility, reunification/recovery
areas, hours of operation, training,
equipment needs, site capacities,
parking area, verify yearly!!

Staff Training in Crisis Protocols

Act 309 drills (fire, weather, and/or safety)
Evacuation 2 X year to safe site
Evacuate 1 X monthly from building
Substitute Teachers & Food Service
Board review and Admin sign off
Reunification plans & Procedures
HS to offer training in CPR, CCR, AED

Reference NIMS, ICS, Safety and Medical training
Reference insurance carrier, FEMA, EHSC consultant

Off-Hour Activities

Field Trips with Bus Driver awareness/training

Rental Plans (user expectations, medical services, weather protocols, environmental services)

Sports Activities (spectator code of conduct, weather plans, medical emergencies)

How to notify coaches outside?

Who is in charge?

Trained in Crisis Plan?

Recreational or Custodial oversee usage?
